



RGEC INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Dear Parents and Families,

We know how essential the RGEC Before/After School Programs are to your family, and we want to keep you informed about how weather-related school delays and cancellations affect our services.

When inclement weather disrupts school schedules, the RGEC Before/After School Programs will be directly impacted. Here's how it works:

- **Two-Hour Delays:** If a school district has a two-hour delay, there will be NO RGEC Before School Programs.
- **School Cancellations:** If schools are canceled due to weather, there will be NO RGEC Before or After School Programs.
- **Early Releases:** If schools release students early due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, there will be NO RGEC After School Programs.

These closures occur because, when schools are closed, RGEC staff do not have access to school facilities, which unfortunately prevents us from offering our programs. We understand this can be inconvenient and apologize for any disruption it may cause. Please know that we are committed to supporting your family during these situations.

RGEC follows the weather-related delay and cancellation policies of the Albuquerque, Belen, Edgewood/Moriarty, Los Cruces, Los Lunas, Rio Rancho, Santa Rosa & Socorro school districts. For more information, please refer to the Parent-Student Handbook, where these policies are outlined.
